Applicants with academic and practical backgrounds in one or more of the following areas are encouraged to apply: public policy, housing, community development, labor, economic mobility, social justice, philanthropy, front-end web development.

Successful candidates will demonstrate an orientation toward social impact and innovation, strong writing ability, strong research and analytical skills, ability to work in a fast-paced environment, a high degree of self-motivation, and ability to collaborate and work as part of a diverse, fully remote team. Primary Responsibilities and Duties

- Research and create short posts that engage site users and promote tools and actions they can take on CentriLife.
- Help create and maintain an editorial calendar to correspond to important events, seasons, etc., such as tax season, Affordable Care Act sign-up windows, holidays, etc.
- Research other websites, mobile apps, and video-based content to include as recommendations to users of CentriLife, adhering to our standards for inclusion for existing or new sections of content.
- Research and identify potential partners (individuals or organizations) that possess expertise, credibility, and authenticity, such as writers, bloggers, video producers, and software/app developers, to enrich CentriLife's content offerings.
- Publish new content to CentriLife using the custom WordPress Content Management System.
